ANNUAL QUALITY ASSURANCE REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2008-09 (IQAC)

The renowned HKE Society of Gulbarga established Siddappa Sangappa Margol College of Arts and Science and Commerce in Shahabad town in June 1967 and recognized by the University Grants Commission under Section 2(F) of University Grants Commission Act in 1967 and under Section 12 (B) in 1982. It is a grant-in-aid college affiliated to Gulbarga University, Gulbarga. Our college was accredited by National assessment and accreditation council in Sept. 2004 and awarded B+ Grade.

The college was started with a vision to impart higher education to the children of rural and industrial workers and create interest in the field of literature, cultural and sports activities among them and to encourage the teaching faculty to under take research work.

It includes elements of applied physics and chemistry, as well as

chemical, mechanical, civil and electrical engineering. With significant media attention to nanoscience and nanotechnology in recent years.

The objective of the seminar is for the interaction among different fields of science, research laboratories, industries, universities and would give a chance to staff, researchers and students to exchange their ideas and acquaint themselves with the latest development in Nanoscience and Green Chemistry an emerging area in chemistry.

As per the need of the hour, computer training is provided to non-teaching staff of the college for the smooth conduct of day to day affairs of the office and clearly enhanced their work efficiency.

The institution has always an agenda in which students occupy a central position and all other are geared towards students satisfaction to ensuring on nurturing creative minds to meet the global challenges, the college has equipped itself with state of the art and technological gazettes. To make teaching more innovative and effective, the college now possesses L. C. D.

To enable students to strengthen their basic knowledge for good living, special coaching classes for SC/ST minority students are being conducted in different subjects. The teachers were motivated to adopt a few poor students for their welfare. This was a new step in bringing up the gap

between the teacher and the taught and also making learning process and enjoyable and pleasant task. Some poor students were adopted by teachers and were extended monetary help along with academic supervision.

The institution has also topped the Alumin sources and also parental support for the betterment of students.
